The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Sweetwater met in their regular monthly meeting on Monday, November 2, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall. Commissioner Moser moved to approve Ordinance No .985 amending Title 14 regarding supplementary provisions on first reading. A second was given. Upon Roll Call Voting, the Ayes were as follows: Commissioners Hughes, Moser, Richeson, West, and Stockton. Nays being none. The motion was carried.

Commissioner West moved to approve Ordinance No. 986 amending Title 14 regarding height limits on first reading. A second was given. Upon Roll Call Voting, the Ayes were as follows: Commissioners Hughes, Moser, Richeson, West, and Stockton. Nays being none. The motion was carried.

Commissioner Hughes moved to approve removing \$1,400 from the receiveable records. The motion was seconded. All voted in favor, with none opposed. The motion was carried.

Mayor Lowe invited those present to the Ribbon Cutting at the Chop Shop on Monday.
